Experiential Learning Terms

ELT1: Sustainable Collectives Exploration (6 weeks) -6 Credit

Sustainable Collectives Exploration is a Six-week immersive module designed to provide students with an understanding of cooperatives, producer companies, SHG federations, and farmer collectives. Through case analysis, field exposure, reflective discussions, and participatory research methods, the module examines governance systems, member participation, business models, and enterprise performance. The learning outcomes are further consolidated through collaborative documentation and publication by students and faculty.

ELT 2 : Sustainable Collectives Management Practicum (11 weeks) -12 Credits

The Collectives Management Practicum is a credit-bearing experiential learning module designed to develop managerial and leadership competencies through supervised engagement with cooperatives, producer organisations, and social enterprises. The practicum provides hands-on exposure to organisational analysis, governance, marketing, operations, finance, and human resource management within participatory institutional settings. It also strengthens professional competencies such as communication, teamwork, facilitation, ethical conduct, transparency, and stakeholder engagement.

Pedagogy:

The program adopts an integrated learning approach based on UNESCO's Four Pillars -Learning to Know, Learning to Do, Learning to Live Together, and Learning to Be -combined with the Principles for Responsible Management Education (PRME) Initiative by UNDP Global Compact. It emphasizes experiential learning, reflection, and real-world application through an integral framework that builds Cognitive, Social, and Leadership competencies, preparing students for responsible and impactful roles. Designed to make learning meaningful, the framework promotes active engagement, iteration, supportive social interaction, and a sense of joy and well-being.

Facilities

Digital Library: ASCI has a well-equipped hybrid library with over 1,00,000 books, journals, audio-visual materials, e-journals, databases, newspapers etc. The library also provides research support, circulation, online catalogue, document delivery, database training, and current awareness services.

Faculty: A multidisciplinary team of faculty members with expertise and substantial experience in collectives management leads the program.

Learning Aids: The campus has full-fledged, well-equipped air-conditioned conference / Lecture rooms equipped with facilities like computers, Internet, Audio-Visual facilities and Office-Automation aids, etc.

Computer based Business Simulation Lab: Well-equipped high-end terminals for conducting business simulation and analytics labs using the latest software tools.

Internet: The campus has a good computer network, dedicated High-Speed Internet connectivity and it is fully Wi-Fi enabled.

Campus Visit

Certificate Verification: During the campus visit, candidates are required to carry all eligibility-related documents, including valid Common Admission Test scores, 10th and 12th certificates, graduation-related documents, Transfer Certificate, Aadhaar Card, and two passport-size photographs.

Admission Kit Collection: Upon completion of the certificate verification process, candidates will be provided with the Admission Kit and the Administrative Staff College of India (ASCI) PGD-SCM Handbook.

Scholarship Support

Participants in the PGD-SCM program may be eligible for scholarship support based on their academic performance in each Interactive Learning and Experiential Term. The scholarship is intended to encourage consistent academic excellence throughout the program.

This academic support is available only to students who clear all subjects in their first attempt without any backlogs.

Career Opportunities

Graduates of the program are well-equipped to pursue careers across diverse sectors, including development organizations, agribusiness enterprises, cooperatives, and government agencies. They can take up roles such as management trainees, project managers, operations managers, research analysts, and program coordinators. The program prepares students to contribute effectively to both corporate and social sectors.

Placement Support

ASCI provides structured placement support through its dedicated placement cell, which maintains strong linkages with industry and institutional partners. Students receive guidance in resume building, interview preparation, and career planning. Regular interactions with industry professionals and recruiters ensure that students are well-prepared for employment opportunities. The institution has a track record of facilitating placements across diverse sectors.

Accommodation

Hostel: The campus provides on-site hostel facilities with double occupancy, non-air-conditioned rooms. Separate accommodations are available for female students, ensuring privacy and security.

Dining: The campus features comprehensive dining services, offering breakfast, lunch, and dinner at designated hours. Both vegetarian and non-vegetarian options are available, catering to diverse dietary preferences. Non-residential students can also avail themselves of these dining facilities on a payment basis.

Admission Eligibility

Who Can Apply

- Recent Graduates aspiring to build careers in Collective Enterprises, Cooperatives, FPOs, Agri-business, and Rural Development.
- Sponsored Graduates supported by Government, Non-Government, Development, or Community-based Organisations.
- 15% seats reserved for the Armed Forces Personnel and their wards with 5% Rebate on the Tuition Fee.
- Sponsored Employee Graduates currently working in Collective Enterprises, Cooperatives, NGOs, Producer Companies, or Promotional Agencies seeking professional advancement.

Essential

- * Graduates from any discipline are eligible.
- * Preference will be given to graduates from Agriculture and Allied sectors.
- * Minimum CGPA of 5.00/10.00 or 50% aggregate marks (or equivalent).
- * Valid score for admission to PG management education for the batch 2026-27 in any one of the following common entrance exams: CAT, MAT, CMAT, ATMA, GMAT, or XAT or those conducted by respective State Governments.

For Final-Year Students

- ◆ Candidates in the final year of their Bachelor's degree should provide GPA/Percentage of Marks obtained at least up to the Third Year (in case of a four-year program) and the Second Year (in case of a three-year program).
- ◆ Candidates in the final year may apply, provided they furnish evidence of meeting the minimum eligibility criteria by September 2026.
- ◆ Final-year candidates should have completed all graduation requirements before the commencement of the program in July 2026.

Academic Diversity

PGD SCM program encourages academic diversity and prefers candidates with a background education and/or work experience in:

- Agriculture, Horticulture and other allied sectors
- Dairy Science, Dairy Technology, Veterinary Sciences
- Food Sciences and Food Technology
- Science, Engineering, Commerce
- Arts and Social Sciences

Please Note:

If selected, candidates failing to meet the minimum eligibility criteria will be required to withdraw from the program.

The fees paid by such candidates will be forfeited unless Administrative Staff College of India (ASCI) fills the vacant seats through new admissions.

The PGD-SCM program will have multiple rounds of selection based on the pool of applicants. The above criteria will be applied for each round. A separate merit list will be prepared for each round of selection.

Admission Process

Step 1: Registration and Payment of Application Fee

Step 2: SCM Aptitude Test

The SCM Aptitude Test will be conducted online after successful registration.

Step 3: Admission Interview

Shortlisted candidates will be invited for an Admission Interview, either in person or online, along with additional group processes, if any.

Step 4: Selection

Provisional admission will be granted to selected candidates. The offer letter will be sent via email and post.

Step 5: Commitment Fee

Selected candidates are required to pay a Commitment Fee of Rs. 50,000 to confirm provisional admission.

Program Fee

The PGP–SCM program is designed to be accessible and inclusive, particularly for candidates committed to working in the sustainable collective enterprises ecosystem.
